RULES & RELEASE

- Pre-entries must be post marked by July 9 and mailed to Chasin' Time Productions, ATTN: Jessie Ann Chrisman, PO Box 608, Big Piney, WY 83113.
- Day of event entries will be cash only.
- Payout will be in cash.
- No duplicate teams are allowed. Teams must swap at least one member to be a 'new' team. There is no cap on the amount of teams.
- The Ag Center will be split in half so two teams can run safely at the same time.
- Each team will consist of four team members. Two team members start on horseback in the assigned arena. The cattle must be at the other end of the arena before teams are allowed to start. The other two members will be in the designated area with the branding pot.
- The judge will decide placement of the brand prior to the first teams running.
- When time is signaled, one teammate will rope a cow around the head or horns, another teammate will then heel the cow around the hind leg(s). Before the cow may be branded, it must be stretched, two hind feet, two front feet, and horses faced. Once the horses are faced, the team members working the ground will string both hind feet and front feet. There is no penalty for a cow kicking out of the rope, but all feet must be strung before the cow is branded. Once the cow is branded, the two team members working the ground must return back to the branding pot and place the iron back in the pot. Ropers will swap after the first cow is branded.
- A neck catch with a front leg will be accepted as a legal catch.
- Dropping loops and belly catches will not be allowed.
- Any roughing of the cattle (ex: high-hocking, choking, figure 8 [neck and two front legs], etc. will result in a team being disqualified.
- Any cattle that have been roughed up (ex: broken leg, etc.) will require the cowboy or cowgirl responsible for the accident to pay the stock provider the market cost for the cow.
- Stalls and RV hookups are available.
- Pursuant to W.S. 1-1-122 - 123, "Any person who takes part in any sport or recreational opportunity assumes the inherent risks in that sport or recreational opportunity, whether those risks are known or unknown, and is legally responsible for any and all damage, injury or death to himself or other persons or property that results from the inherent risks in that sport or recreational activity" I am aware of the risks, dangers, and hazards associated with this equine activity and I freely accept and fully assume all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting there-from. I agree to hold harmless Jessie Ann Chrisman, Chasin' Time Productions and its agents, employees, and associates, Sublette County Fairgrounds, Sublette County Fair Board, and their affiliates from any loss, damage, expense, or injury to any third party resulting from my participation in this activity. I confirm that I have read and understand this liability release prior to signing it, and I am aware that by signing this agreement that I am waiving certain legal rights which I or my heirs may have against the release.
- All team members must sign this release upon checking in that states they agree with and am aware, have read, and will abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Sublette County Team Branding and the Sublette County Fairgrounds.
